



POLICE OFFICER

The City of Warrenton is accepting applications for a full-time reliable Police Officer. This job earns a competitive pay of \$25.00-25.75/hr DOQ. The position of a Police Officer is responsible for the protection of life and property through active, continuous enforcement of the laws and ordinances. Duties encompass the various aspects of crime prevention, traffic accident investigations, on-the-scene interviews of witnesses and participants in various incidents wherein statutes and/or ordinances are violated, traffic control, and special assignments. Officers must be available to work rotating shifts, nights, weekends, 12 hour shifts, Requires the ability to perform foot pursuits, subdue suspects resisting arrest, etc.

Requirements: Must be a citizen of the United States at the time of application, Missouri resident at the time of appointment for sworn position, no felony record or serious misdemeanor, minimum age of 21 years, high school diploma or equivalent, and must hold a valid Missouri Class B P.O.S.T. license. Sworn positions must hold valid driver's license from any state at time of application and a valid Missouri driver's license at time of appointment, previous experience dealing with public, must have honorable discharge from military, if applicable.

Selection Process: Candidates for employment will be tested using a hurdle system in a variety of areas. All elements of the selection process shall be administered, scored, evaluated, and interpreted in a uniform manner. The areas of testing include: Written, Oral Board Interview, Physical Fitness, Background Investigation, Psychological Evaluation, Integrity Interview, Drug Test, and Firearms Qualification.
