The City of Warrenton’s Tree-Membrance Program offers participants a unique way to honor a loved one by donating a tree to a City park. The Grounds & Maintenance Department will plant a tree in your selected park and attach a tree tag to it listing the name of the donator(s) and name of the honored person. Program Participants receive a commemorative certificate and a map identifying the location of their donated tree. Trees can grow for several hundred years, making them an enduring, living memorial for a loved one or a wonderful way to honor someone.

The Tree you Dedicate

Tree species is determined by location and you may select from the listed options at the desired location. Tree Membrance trees are approximately 2-2 ½ inches in caliper and 5-6 feet tall. The location of your tree must be selected from the available locations as listed on the map. Trees ordered between January 1 and June 30 will be planted between November 15 and January 31. Trees ordered between July 1 and December 31 will be planted between February 1 and April 30. Trees have a 1 year replacement guarantee. If a Tree Membrance tree should die within 1 year of its original planting, a replacement will be planted during the next available planting season.

Cost

Tree Membrance trees can be donated at the cost of \$240 each. Please contact City Hall at 636-456-3535 to obtain tree selection information or to arrange for on-line payment.
